 - Aircraft financing quote (if applicable)

 - File state incorporation paperwork
 - Acquire FEIN from IRS
 - File IRS tax-exempt application -- Form 1024-EAA offers guidance
- Select aircraft and club structure.
- Finalize club documents.

 - Safety policies
